- * You can only choose **ONE** option in July. You cannot take a full credit remote, e-Summer July course, dual credit, and Remote Credit Recovery at the same time!
- * The only program available in the August session is the e-Summer School August session.

Notes	This is the model for the remedial summer program for students who have taken a course within the last two years but did not successfully earn the credit. Unlike the remedial summer school program, there is no minimum required mark needed for Remote Credit Recovery.	In our In Person & Remote Learning models students will be either at home learning live with their teacher or in person learning face-to-face daily from 9:00 a.m. to 11:45 a.m. and again from 12:30 p.m.- 3:15 p.m.	Most class time is asynchronous with about one hour/day of synchronous lessons with the teacher. Students are expected to log into Brightspace every day and submit work according to the class schedule. Students should commit about six hours daily to their course. Students who do not log in within the first week may be removed from the course. The TDSB e-Summer OUAC/OCAS transmission dates are August 2nd, 2022, for the July Session and August 30th, 2022 for the August Session. If you are in a graduating position, and plan to attend a post-secondary institution in September 2022, we strongly recommend taking your e-Summer course in the July session. Your future post-secondary institution may not accept your final mark sent in the end of August transmission. If you have questions about final dates that a post-secondary institution will accept summer school marks, please contact the post-secondary institution's admissions office. The e-Summer office cannot guarantee final marks will be available for submission to OCAS/OUAC or directly to students before end of August 2022
